PURPOSE

To construct a more secure, effective, and inviting environment in our preschool, children, student, and worship spaces. This would be accomplished in the following ways:

FIRST FLOOR SPACE:

A general entry at the covered drive and simpler navigation through the main corridor.

Secure zones for preschool and elementary spaces, with checkin entry points for each. An open assembly space for children.


Maximized space for preschool and children's ministry.

SECOND FLOOR SPACE:

Securable points of entry to student area, with ability to isolate access to gym. An open assembly space for students. Maximized space for student ministry.

WORSHIP CENTER:

Adding fire sprinkler protection. Relocating cameras from the aisles. Replacing pews and house lighting. Renovating the choir room. Upgrading audio, screens, and stage lighting.




01 FIRST FLOOR PLAN

HOW WILL THIS CONSTRUCTION HELP US REACH OUR COMMUNITY FOR CHRIST?

Secure and effective ministry spaces are of great concern to families, especially those with kids and students. Also, a more functional and inviting worship space helps everyone to better see, hear, and experience our worship service. Addressing these issues will allow us to increase our gospel impact through these spaces. This project also makes future expansion of our building possible, which would enable us to reach even more people.

HOW WILL WE PAY FOR THIS?

With God's guidance, and the sacrificial giving of Hurstbourne Baptist Church, we believe we can meet the financial challenges of construction. The RENEW campaign asks all of us to make a three-year giving commitment to impact future generations through this project.

WAYS TO GIVE









DECREASE

Are there things in your life you can do less frequently? Maybe it's fewer coffee shop runs, or one less dinner out each week, or changing how you receive media in your home. By decreasing a weekly expense, regardless of what it might be, you can save a significant amount over three-years time to invest in this vision.

DO MORE

Often, there are creative ways to save money. Maybe it's been a while since you requested a quote for an existing service (e.g., cell phone or cable service). Perhaps you could do some extra comparison or bargain shopping to save funds.

DELAY

Are there plans you might be making that involve a financial commitment? If so, prayerfully ask God about delaying those plans and using the savings to contribute.

DONATE

A great way to contribute is to give existing assets. Consider giving appreciated assets (stocks, bonds, real estate) to the church. Letting us sell your assets eliminates potential capital gains taxes and may increase after-tax proceeds. Other items (such as antiques, jewelry and sports memorabilia) are better off being sold and cash is given to the church. For more information please contact the church office.

CAMPAIGN GOALS

Our Team of Pastors and our Building for the Future committee have been seeking wisdom and praying earnestly to discern God's will in this process. We have three potential goals in this campaign. The first goal is set at an attainable \$2 Million. The second goal may stretch us, set at \$3.5 Million.
