We are excited to be hosting our 3rd annual Pursue Mission Conference on February 21-23. I hope you are able to join us at some point over the weekend. My concern in hosting a "mission" conference is that anyone who is not a missionary or who is not considering being a missionary will think this moment is not for them. That could not be further from the truth. The goal of Pursue is to help HBC grow in our obedience to God's design for His church. The "mission" God has given to the church is to make disciples of Jesus. Missions and missionaries are necessary to accomplish that goal, but so are pastors, deacons, Sunday school teachers, children's

choir directors, VBS volunteers, blue collar workers, white collar workers, stay at home moms, grandmas and grandpas. In short, the Lord commissioned every believer and every church to be making disciples of all peoples in all places until Jesus returns. And our prayer is that the Pursue weekend will help you see just where you fit in this Great Commission God has given to all of us.

The weekend will begin on Friday, February 21st, with dinner and worship. Dinner will be from 5:30-6:45pm in the Fellowship Hall. During dinner the team of Pastors will be answering questions about missions and disciple making and how the Great Commission influences their families and ministries. At 7pm everyone will gather in the Worship Center where we will sing,



pray, and hear a word from IMB Missionary to Israel, Drake Hyman. For any who can make plans to stay late, following a brief break after worship, we will conclude the night with a time of prayer for HBC and our Mission Partners from 8:30-9:00pm.

Saturday will begin with a Men's breakfast in the Fellowship Hall from 8:30-10:00am. Travis Wall from Team Expansion will be our speaker and will be sharing about his work among members of unreached people groups living in Louisville, KY. Next, our Bright Promise and Dobbins McNeely Women's Missionary Union groups will host a Women's Tea from 1:00pm-2:30pm Saturday afternoon. Lynn Foster, an IMB missionary who serves in East Africa, will be sharing her journey to work among an unreached people group in that region. To bring the weekend to a close, we will have Patrick & Jessica Alyea (FCA director at Ball St. University), Jamie Johnson (Kids for Christ), and Travis

& Jill Wall (Team Expansion) sharing to various Sunday School classes on Sunday morning.

My hope and prayer, whether or not you are able to attend the Pursue Mission Conference, is that through the ministry of HBC your love for and trust in Jesus would be ever increasing. And that you would find great joy in joining Him and His church as we seek to make disciples of all peoples in all places.
