As fall begins, so begins our time for Worship Center renovations. While we transition temporarily to the gym for our Sunday corporate worship, our corporate worship will continue consistently. Moving to a different location will assuredly grow our anticipation to return to the Worship Center that God has graciously provided for us here. Yet, God reminds us from His Word that a specific location is not what He seeks in true worshipers.

In John 4, Jesus encounters the Samaritan woman at the well and gives us an important lesson on the relationship between worship and physical location. The woman, perceiving Jesus' prophetic abilities, asks Him a pressing theological question. She desires to know, as a Samaritan, where the true center of worship was: Samaria or Jerusalem (v. 20)? Jesus, surprisingly, answers the question by saying neither location was superior for worship (v. 21). In fact, He goes on to explain that "the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth, for the Father is seeking such people to worship him" (v. 23).

What does Jesus mean when He says the Father is seeking worshipers who worship Him in "spirit and truth"? There are various interpretations of Jesus' statement, but I believe the surrounding context makes clear that Jesus is continuing to make an authoritative claim about the location of worship. In other words, the kind of worshipers the Father is seeking are worshipers who are not dependent on any one physical location, whether that is Samaria, the temple in Jerusalem, or anywhere else. Since God is spirit (not bound to a single location; v. 24), the Father is seeking worshipers who are not bound to any single location.

Wherever God is present by His Spirit, worship is not only possible but also sought after by the Father (see Psalm 139:1-12). This is a profound change from the Old Testament, where worship was centered around the tabernacle and temple. Now that God has taken on flesh (literally "tabernacled"; John 1:14) in Jesus, worship must center around Jesus.

As for worshipping the Father "in truth," I believe Jesus is making the claim that worship must be centered around Himself. John's Gospel makes clear that Jesus is the Truth of Scripture realized (John 1:14, 17; 14:6). The Father is seeking worship that is profoundly Christ-centered, where all the promises of God are yes in Him (2 Cor 1:20). Therefore, worship that the Father seeks is not tied to any single place, but to any place where His Spirit resides, to magnify Christ.

As we move our gathering place for corporate worship, remember that the worship God seeks is worship that magnifies Christ, no matter the physical location. As God's people gather weekly, God's presence powerfully sustains His saints through His Word. May Christ be magnified in our worship this fall as we worship the Father in spirit and truth.
